







#### Terezín / Theresienstadt

Place of Cilla's death

The first indirect mention of the Jewish settlement of Prague dates back to the 10th century. From the Middle Ages until 1848, Prague's Jewish population was compulsorily concentrated in the Jewish Town, the largest Central European ghetto. In the years 1896-1911, a large part of the Jewish town was demolished. In 1930, 35,450 Jews lived in Prague, most of them died in Nazi concentration camps.

Terezín was built in the years 1780 - 1790 as a fortress guarding the northern approaches to the interior of Bohemia. In 1782, it was granted the status of a city, the life of which was closely connected with the military garrison. The small fortress, forming part of the Terezín fortress system, served as a prison and penitentiary for military and political prisoners during the Habsburg Monarchy.

The years of World War II represent the most tragic period in the city's history. The German occupiers first established a Prague Gestapo police prison in the Small Fortress in June 1940, and then on November 24, 1941, a ghetto in the city itself. This collection and transit camp was intended first for Jews from the then Protectorate of Bohemia and Moravia, later also from Germany, Austria, the Netherlands, Denmark and Slovakia.
















